- The barium graph of the esophagus is done in order to examine the swallowing distress or the feeling of obstruction of the esophagus caused by food. The examination reveals esophagus constriction, ulcer, stomach hernia, or movement problems occur during the transition from the esophagus to the food.
- The barium graph is done in the X-ray section. You will be asked not to eat or drink anything at least six hours ago before procedure.
- You will be asked to stand in front of an X-ray machine and drink a special white liquid along with some barium. This substance will make the esophagus visible. A piece of bread or candy can be given to you to eat. This allows the appearance of muscle movements in the esophagus.
- The films of the esophageal movements that occur during swallowing are recorded serially.
- A few days after the test, you can defecate chalk-colored stools. This is harmless and is caused by barium.
- You should take as many fluids as possible to avoid constipation within 2-3 days after the procedure.



When is it done?

- Dyspepsy
- Pain sensation during swallowing
- Acid went into esophagus
- Esophageal perforation, tear suspicion
- Preoperative assessment

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When should not be done?

Aspiration

Substances used for this procedure

The most used substance is “Barium”.

Preparing patient for filming

- Informing patient,
- Asking if patient is pregnant,
- Preparing patient psychologically and by explaining the basics of procedure,
- Stomach should be empty since barium will be taken.

Filming Process



While the patient is standing, swallowing the prepared barium mixture, complete esophagus is filmed serially. Generally also stomach and duodenum are filmed. (ESD-Esophagus Stomach Duodenum Graph)

After the procedure

After the procedure, the patient should be warned for constipation and should drink plenty of water.

Complications

Barium mixture go into the trachea

Barium leak in patients with perforation who had not have any suspicion of perforation.
